# Lowell General Hospital Auxiliary Annual Meeting 2019



Nearly 50 members of the Lowell General Hospital Auxiliary and hospital leadership attended the Auxiliary's annual meeting on Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup> at Stonehedge Inn & Spa in Tyngsboro.

The Auxiliary is a group of volunteers and supporters of the hospital who work year-round to hold events and raise funds to support the services and care provided by Lowell General Hospital. The group also operates the Gift Shops at the Main and Saints campuses.

This year, the Main campus
Gift Shop was redesigned to
provide space for the addition of
an adjacent pharmacy service.
Auxiliary President Susan Dionne
thanked the entire Gift Shop
Committee – Mary Bennett, Pauline
Lambert, Paula Leavitt, Suzanne
L'Hussier, Deb Lemos and Deb Trull
– for their help and guidance during
the renovation.

The Auxiliary also presented Lowell General Hospital President and CEO Jody White with a check for \$125,000, part of the group's four-year \$500,000 pledge to the Main campus Intensive Care Unit renovation and expansion of the adjacent outdoor healing garden. Jody thanked the Auxiliary for their continued support as well as their partnership with the creation of the new Gift Shop/Pharmacy space.

Flowers were presented to Sarah Taylor and Maria Doherty of the Gift Shop for their patience and dedication to the Gift Shop, as well as to Kelly Will, Philanthropy Services Manager, for her yearlong support.

Daffodils and Desserts Co-Chairs Pauline Lambert and Mary Bennett presented the proceeds of their March event to Meg Lemire-Berthel and Elisa Shanahan of the Cancer Center.

The record breaking net proceeds of \$6,400 were used to purchase new chairs for the Cancer Center Infusion Room and Market Basket gift cards to provide holiday meals to patients in treatment.

Designed to provide convenient prescription services for patients before they leave the hospital, the administration sees the addition of the new retail

pharmacy as critical to fulfilling the hospital's mission of providing Complete connected care.

The pharmacy also offers a wide variety of over-the-counter (OTC) medications, convenience items, wellness products, and even

prescriptions for pets (for human medications prescribed to pets such as Prednisone and Xanax). As an added benefit, OTC medications are priced below many of the major retail pharmacies.

The grand opening was held on Tuesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. Staff, patients, and members of the community enjoyed free cake, discounts on OTC medications, Gift Shop purchases, and chances to win some great raffle prizes.
